Expand into Europe and beyond

- + more members = more input = more support
- + include less-well (vendor) supported facilities
- less exclusive and more impersonal harder to get to know everyone
- +/- go abroad for meetings

Expand membership outside facility staff

- academics often have different priorities
- NMRDG already exists (without mail list, but uses UKMRM + Dror's list)

We need a meeting for the network of NMR facility managers

Expand into Europe and beyond?

We should all be members of AMMRL anyway – perhaps there could be a European meeting of AMMRL


We could invite international membership of UKMRM and they could join our meeting
